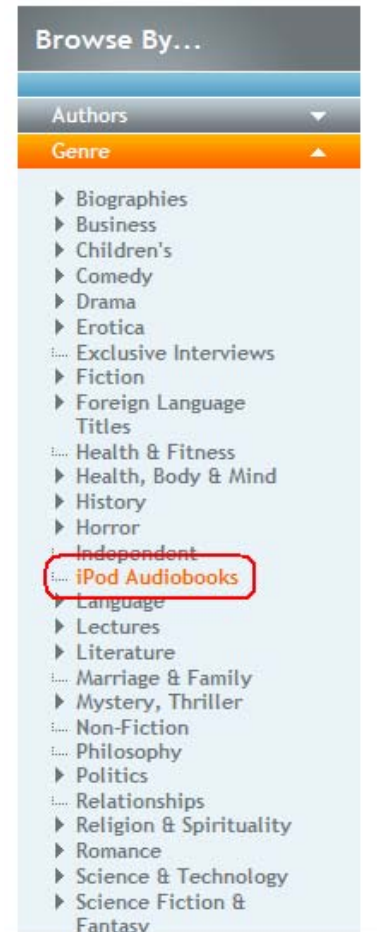
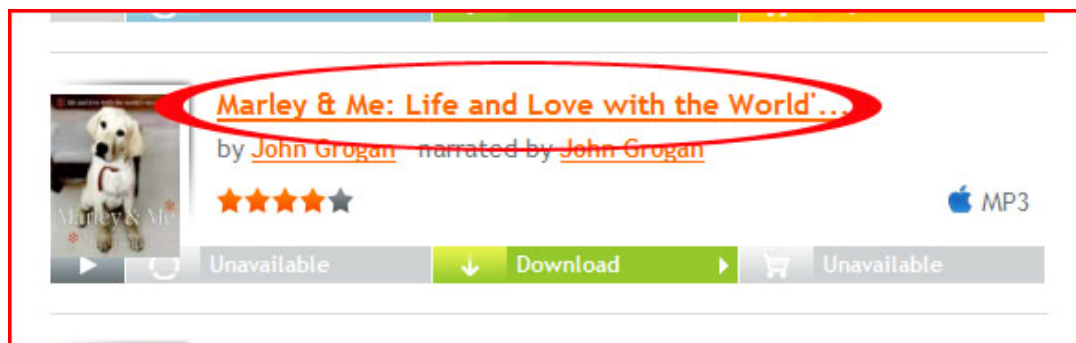


## How To: Download and Play iPod compatible audio books

First you will need to search for the book you would like to download. You may want to search through our iPod Audiobooks section, or simply search for a title that you are interested in.



To see more information about a certain title, simply click on the title to bring up the details page.



On the details page you will find more information such as the publisher, length of the title, an overview of the title, and member reviews.

If you would like to download the title, simply click on the green **Download It** button. You will get a pop up which allows you to download the title immediately, or **Save It For Later**.

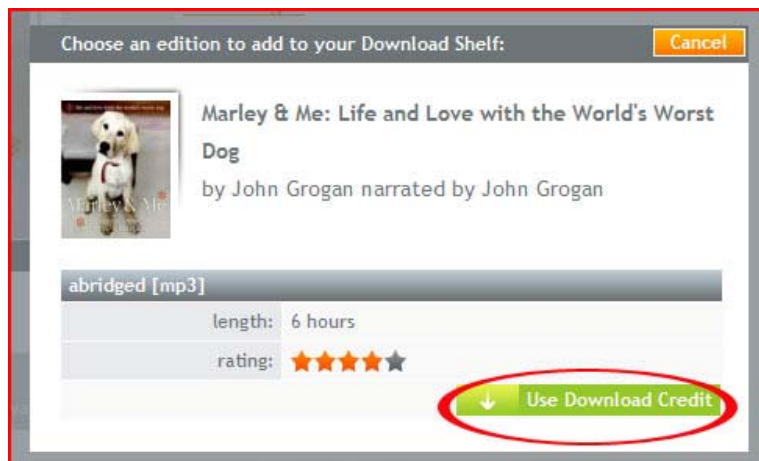
Using the ‘**Save This for Later**’ option is a great way for you to keep track of books of interest that you may want to download in the future. Only have 1 credit left this month but found 3 books you want to download? Use the “Save This for Later” option to easily find these titles again when your new credits are issued.

You can review and download titles from your saved list under **My Books > Saved For Later**. When you are ready to download a title you’ve set aside, simply go to your Saved For Later list, and click on the green download button next to the book you want.

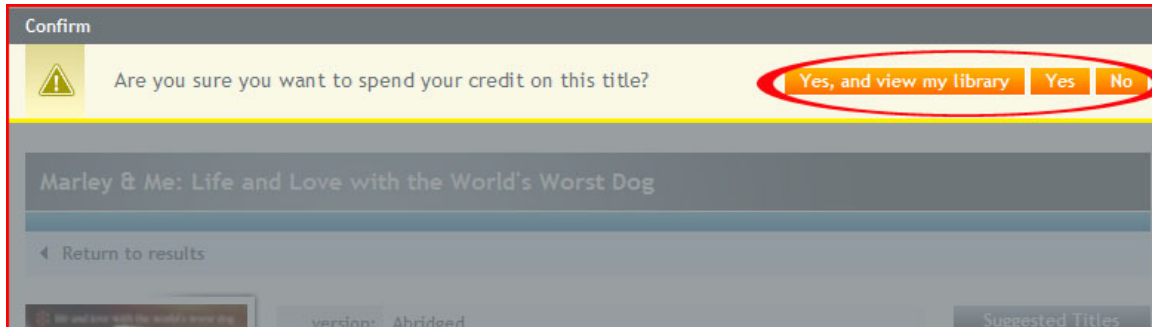


However, if when searching for a title you find one you would like to download now, simply click on the green **Download Now** button in the pop up.

In the next window, click the green “Use Download Credit” button.

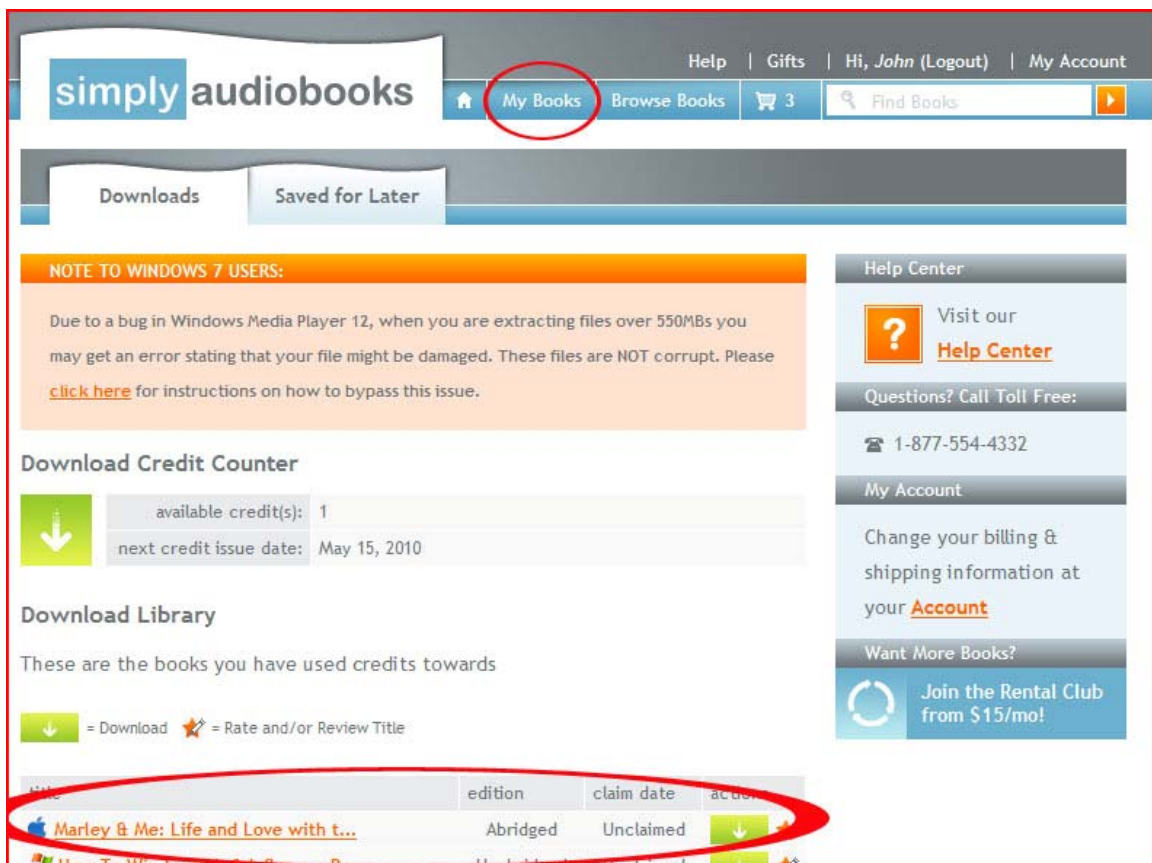


You will then be prompted to confirm that you wish to use a download credit towards this title.

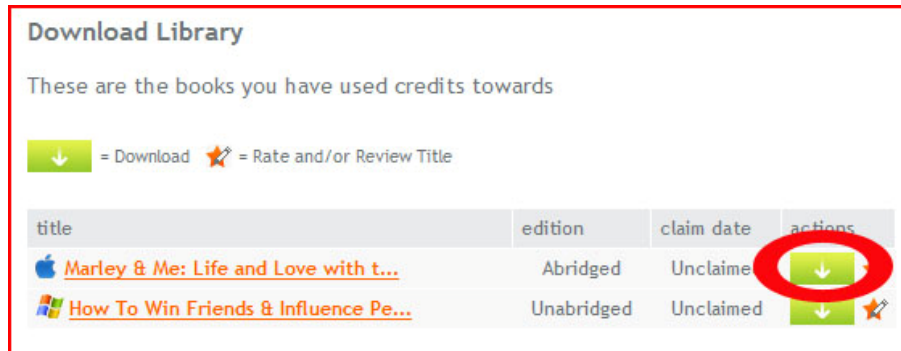


Clicking “Yes, and view my library” will assign a credit towards the title and bring you immediately to your Download Library to continue with the download process.

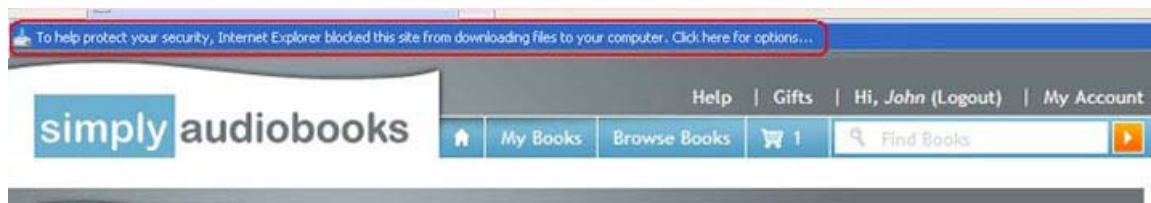
Clicking “Yes” will assign a credit towards the title and keep you on the same page so you can continue browsing books. To view and download the title at any time, click on the **My Books** tab. The book that you have used the credit on will now be listed in your **Download Library**.



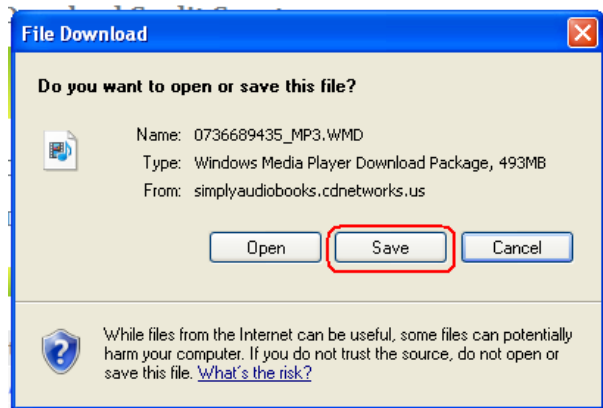
In your Download Library, click the green **Download** button next to the book you want to download to begin the download process.



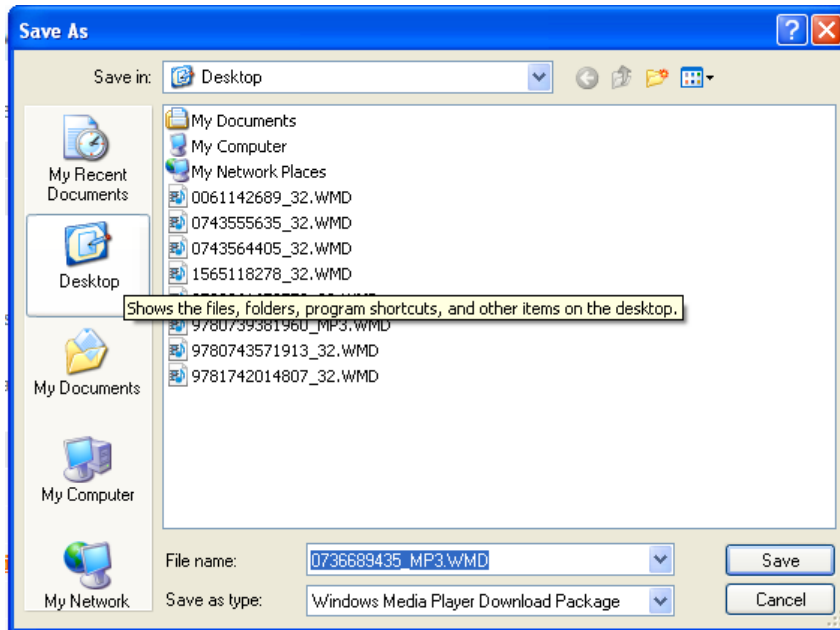
Once you click the green **Download** button, you will then be notified that the file is ready to download. If a security drop down box appears, please click on the drop down setting and choose Download File. You will then have to click on the green download button again.



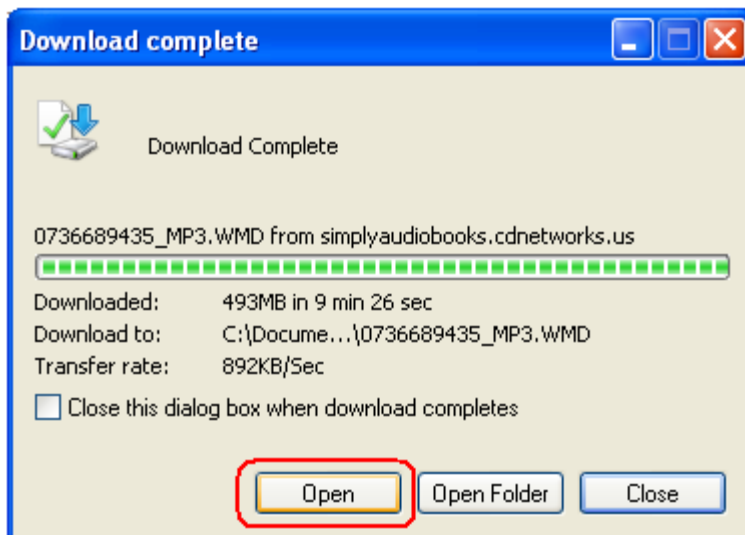
A pop up window will appear asking if you want to open or save the file. Please save the file to your PC by clicking on the **Save** button.



Please select the appropriate location to save the file and then click **Save**. You may not be prompted to choose a location. If you are not prompted, the download will save to the default location you have set on your computer. (This is usually your 'My Music' folder.)

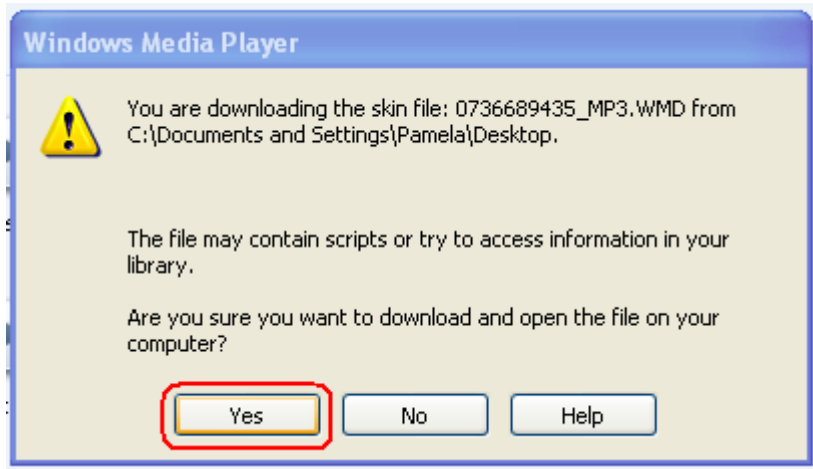


Once the download is complete, select the **Open** option to open the file.



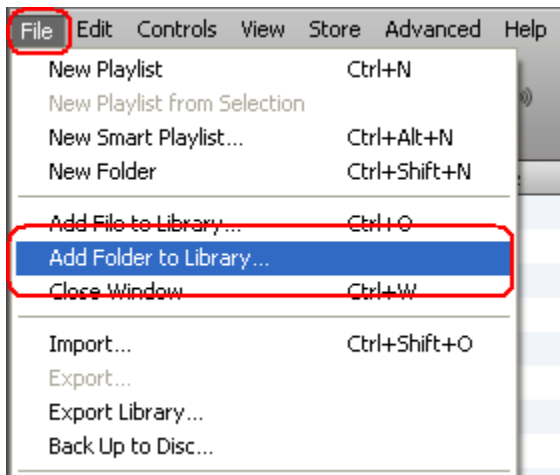
The File will now begin to extract to Windows Media Player. This step is automatic, once you select the open option, your PC will automatically start extracting the audio tracks into Windows Media Player.

Once all the tracks have been extracted into Windows Media Player, you may be presented with a warning message about Script Files. Click **Yes** as the skin file and scripts are not harmful to your PC.

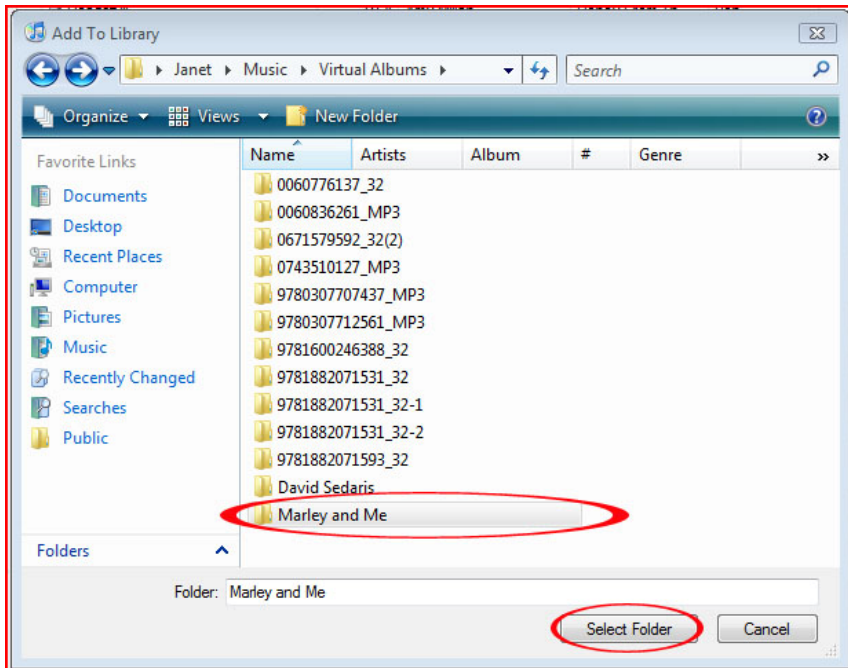


Once the File has fully opened in Windows Media Player (it will start playing), simply close Windows Media Player and open your iTunes.

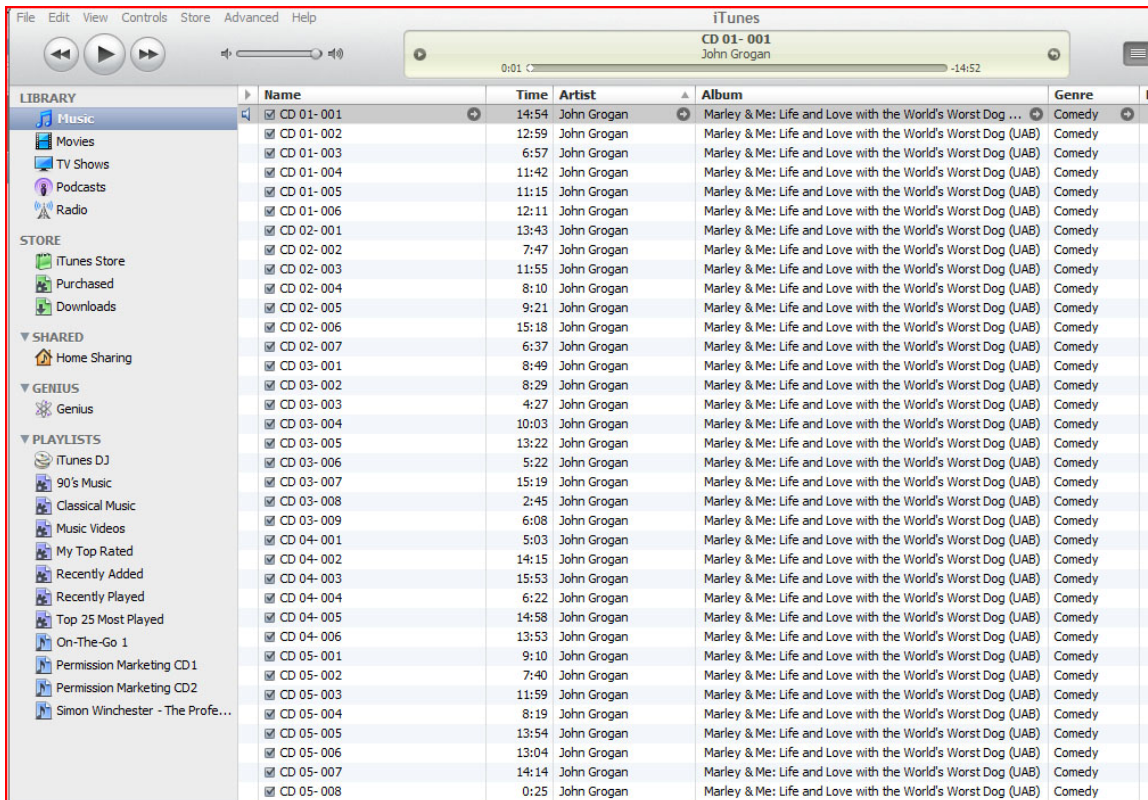
In iTunes choose the File tab and then select **Add Folder to Library**.



From this new pop-up window, please choose the folder containing your audio book (it may be listed under the author's name or as Artist followed by some numbers) and click OK (or Select Folder, depending on your version of iTunes) to add the title to your iTunes.



If the title is split into multiple folders, you will need to ensure that you add all folders to iTunes.



You have now added the title to your iTunes library and can sync it to your iPod.
